Overview

See the fascinating city of Barcelona on a comfortable and convenient hop-on hop-off bus tour. You'll travel on open-top double-decker buses that cover 3 different routes. Your 1-day or 2-day ticket makes it possible see all that Barcelona has to offer!

What to Expect

This Barcelona sightseeing tour features 3 different routes with over 44 stops to choose from! See the major sights aboard an open-top double-decker bus, spending as much time as you like at places of interest to you.

All the key sights and attractions of the city feat on the tour, including the Gothic Quarter in the center of old Barcelona. You can wander around the ancient, winding streets where many of the buildings date from medieval times, and some from as far back as the Roman settlement of Barcelona.

A number of buildings in the city are UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Especially remarkable are the works of architect Antoni Gaudi, which can be seen throughout the city. His best known work is the immense but still unfinished cathedral, Sagrada Familia. This has become a symbol of Barcelona known around the world. Other works by Gaudi that can be seen on the tour include his famous Casa Batllo, Casa Mila, and Park Güell.

You can take time to visit Barcelona's museums, stop off at its many beautiful parks and gardens, or cool off at the beach!

Skip the line access to Sagrada Familia

Overview

Skip the long lines to the Sagrada Familia in Barcelona, and enjoy a 1,5-hour guided tour of Gaudí's Modernisme masterpiece. Learn about the unfinished construction of the basilica at the museum. Then, enjoy panoramic views from the towers.

What to Expect

Explore one of the most iconic buildings in Barcelona on a 1.5-hour guided tour of the Sagrada Familia, conceived by the Modernist architect, Antoni Gaudí at the end of the 19th century.

Skip the long lines to access the interior of the Roman Catholic church, and discover a vibrant clash of Gothic and Art Nouveau designs. Look closely at the symbolic details of each of the 5 aisles of the Latin cross floor plan.

Go to the Sagrada Familia museum to learn about the life and career of its visionary architect. See drawings and models that illustrate the development of the basilica, from its inception to the present day, and its estimated completion in 2026.

Then, take the elevator up the tower, and enjoy panoramic views of Barcelona. Your guide will leave you at the entrance to the tower elevator, leaving you free to explore at leisure.
